- b. If you have already done one of the choices in (a.) or if you are an accelerated math student, consider taking AP Biology, AP Physics, or AP Chemistry, or CMU Human Anatomy for HS and college credit.
- c. Food Science I and II are also options but it isn't HEAR approved.

Reminders

- There are descriptions of every single class in the course guide. Use the **table of contents** to help you figure out which page.
- You have to have six classes per semester (3.0 credits) in order to be considered full-time and be eligible for athletics. Colleges like to see a full senior year.
- In order to have a release, you must have at least a 2.0 GPA and be on track with your credits for graduation (at least 18 completed by the end of this year). No more than two releases first semester.
- **Fill in all elective choices on your form.**
- **Teachers' and parent's or guardian's signatures are required.**
