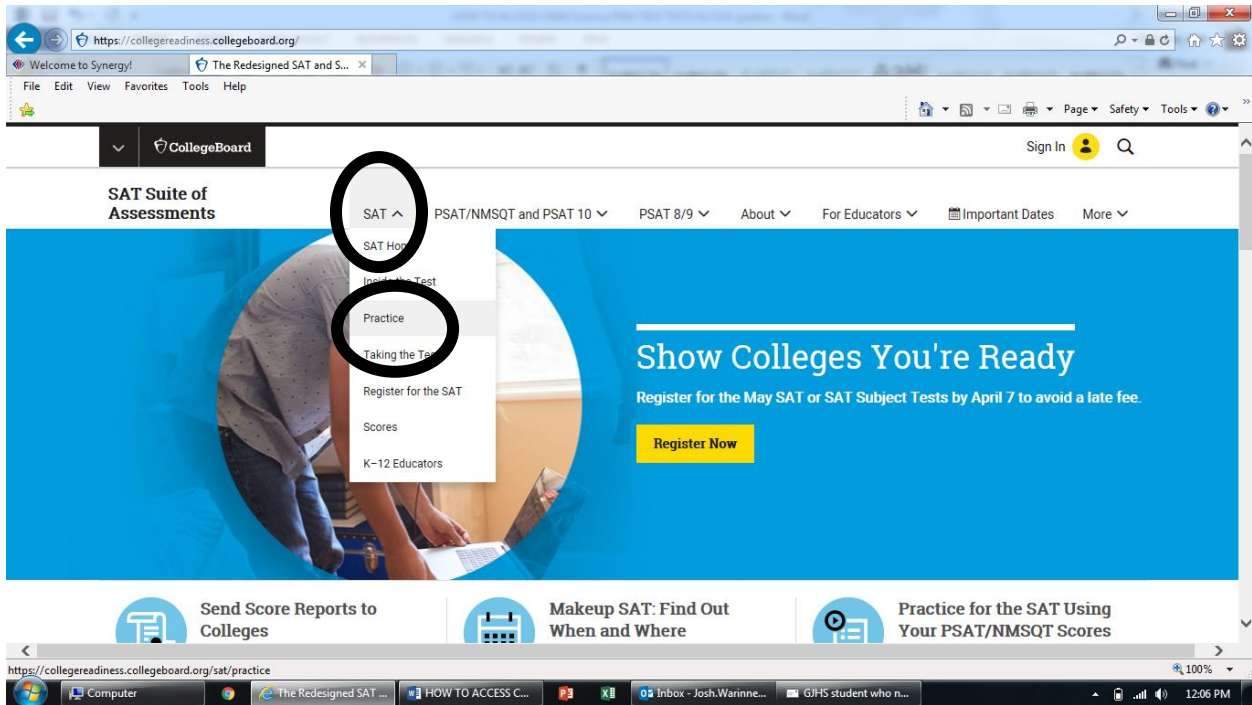
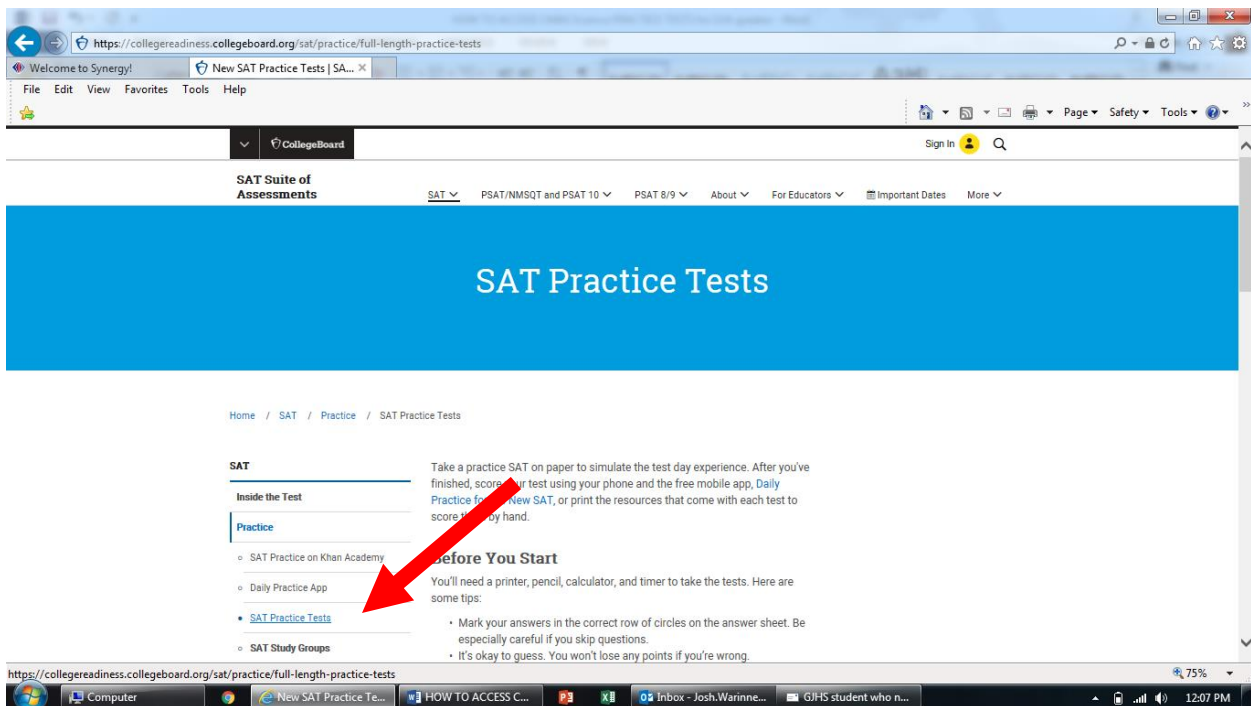


# HOW TO ACCESS SAT PRACTICE TESTS for 11<sup>th</sup> graders:

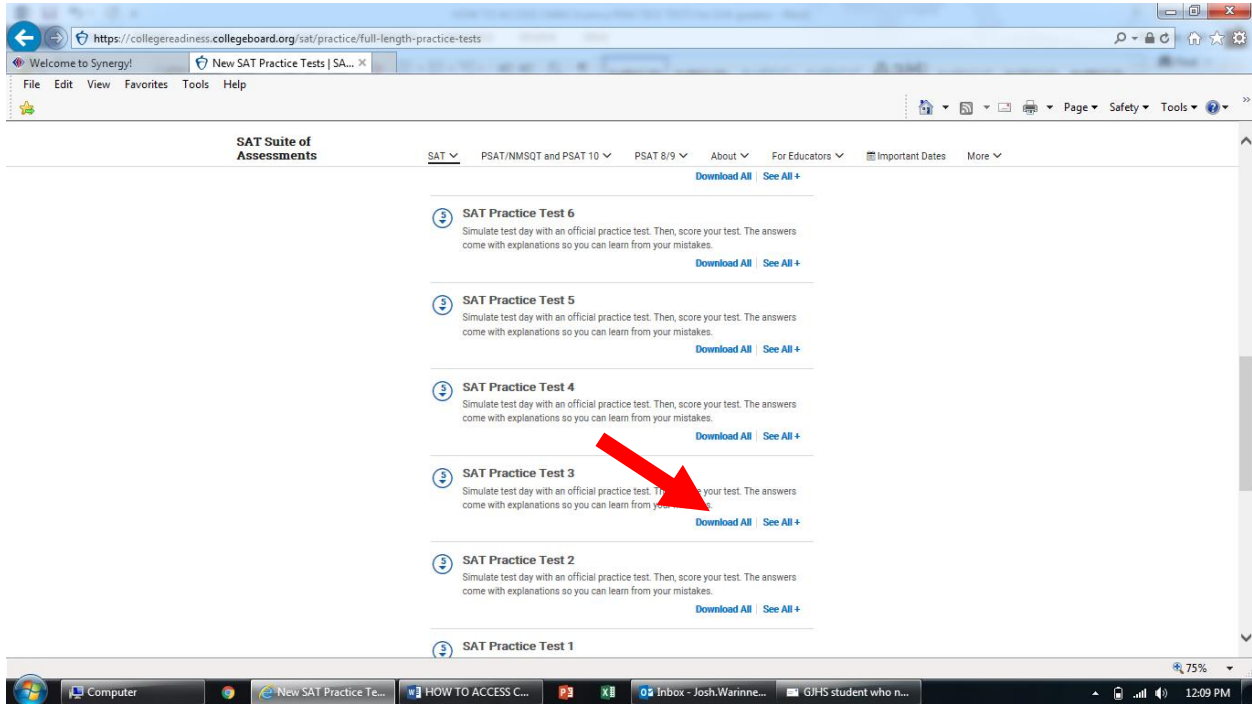
Enter <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/> into web browser. **CLICK SAT-scroll to Practice & click.**



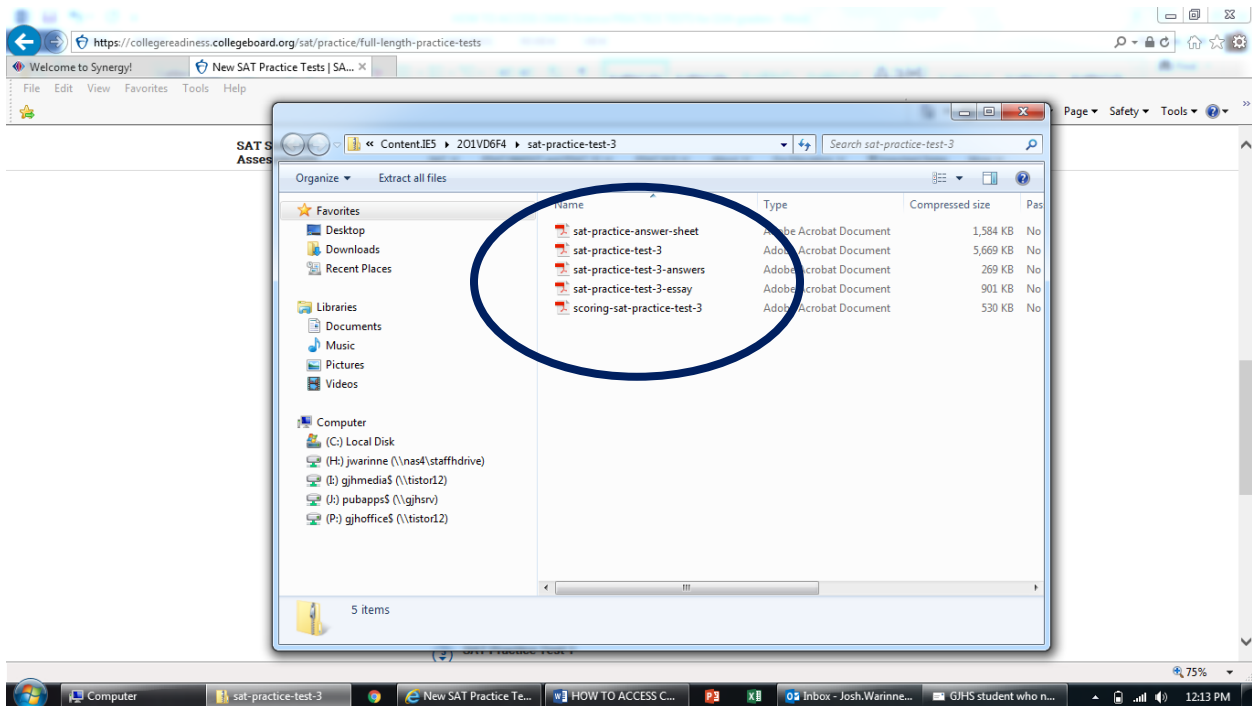
**Click SAT Practice Test**



Scroll Down to a test and click **Download All** – and open once it is downloaded.



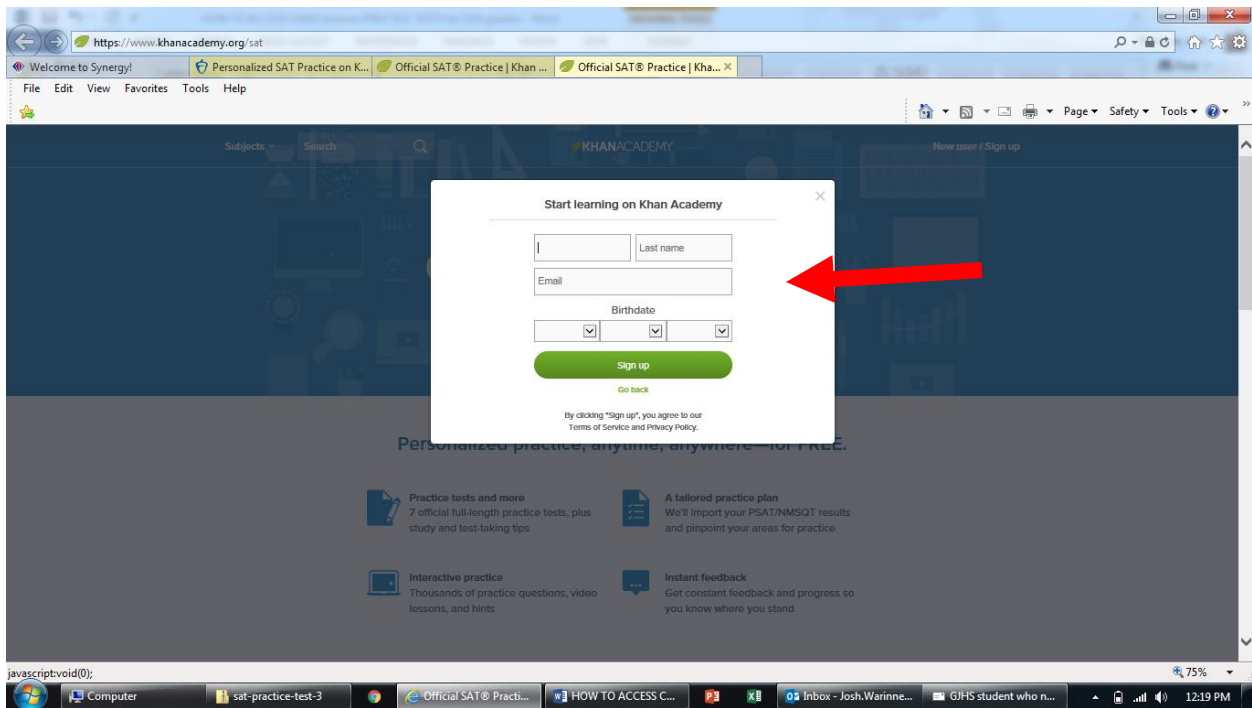
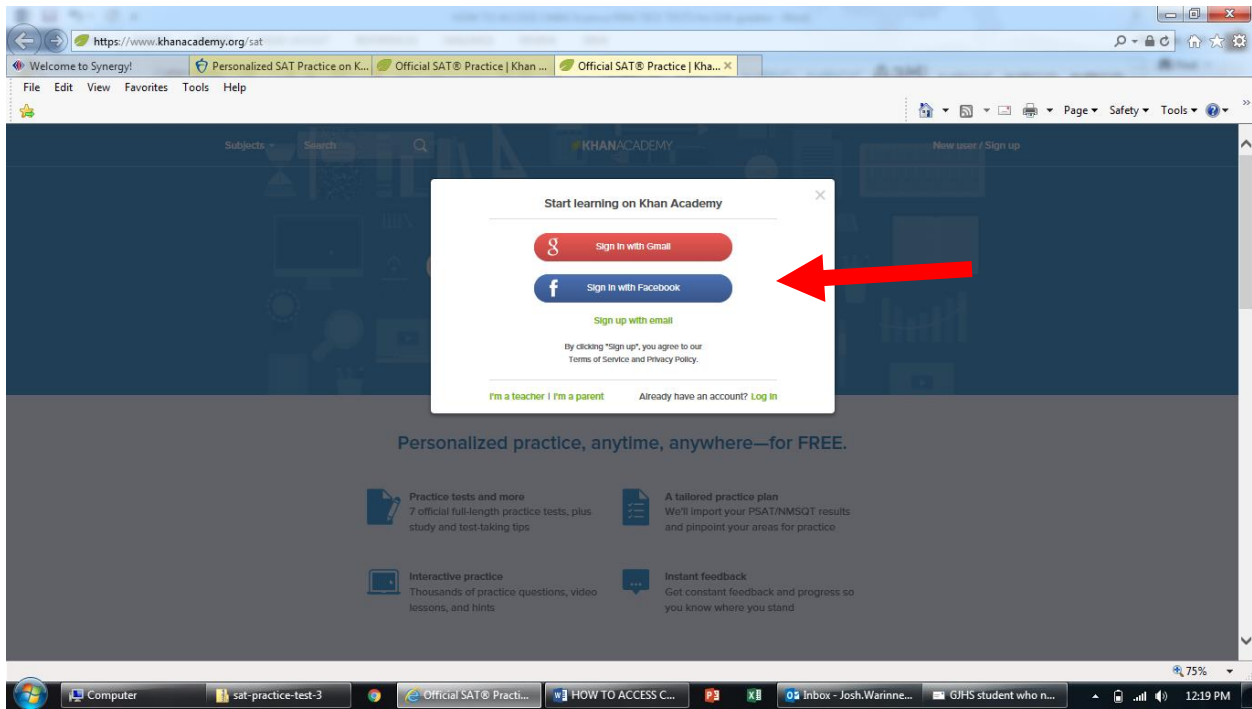
This will be a paper pencil version for you print out and there are also answers to help you so you know why you missed them.
